A month after his trip, Preston was diagnosed with Hodgkin's disease. He has since undergone treatment and is in remission.

Because of my experience when cancer touched our family, I have decided to bicycle across America from San Diego, CA. to Cocoa Beach, FL. to raise money for appropriately the Lance Armstrong Foundation. Today nearly 10 million people are living with cancer, and chances are like me you know one of them. The LAF helps people with cancer focus on living.
